Line breeding and selective outcrosses have resulted in dogs which are consistent in the field and pleasing to the eye. You'll be pleased to see your Kissamee Kennels dog point intensely, back on sight and retrieve eagerly.....all with style high at both ends and at a very early age.



Kissamee Kennels pointers are brought along on quail, huns, pheasants and pigeon. Work is done on wild birds when the season permits. The kennel's own dogs are specialist on Grouse, as well as woodcock and pheasants. Our many satisfied customers have had great success hunting their dogs on all upland species.



The amount of training started dogs sold at our kennel have depends greatly on age and maturity. The majority have had birds shot for them and can be hunted quite comfortably.

A complete training program is available should you prefer to have us work with your hunting companion.

As a service to Kissamee Kennels customers only, we gladly welcome young dogs back for instruction. Six months of age is a great time to begin, usually with a two month stay needed to complete the required program. We are flexible as to the amount of training you may request and will customize our program to suit your needs. You are always welcome to come see your dog's progress as it is being made.



Kissamee Kennels puppies are well socialized and exercised daily. We receive compliments on a regular basis as to how well our our puppies adjust to their new homes and how eager they are to learn. FROM ROUTE 84 EAST (NEW YORK & DANBURY)

Take Route 84 East to Exit 15. At the light at the end of the exit go right onto Route 67. Follow Route 67 south through the village of Southford. 2 1/2 miles past the Southford General Store, turn right onto Hogsback Road. Go up the hill, when you pass Somers Lane on the left, look for house #59 on the left.

FROM I-95 AND MERRITT PARKWAY

Take Exit 27A from I-95 or Exit 52 from the Merritt Parkway onto Route 8 North. Take Route 8 to Exit 22, Bank Street. Go left at the end of the exit, straight to the light under the bridge and left onto Route 67. Follow Route 67 through Oxford Village, as you pass Town Hall on the right, take the next left onto Hogsback Road. Go up the hill, when you pass Somers Lane on the left, look for house #59 on the left.

FROM ROUTE 84 WEST (HARTFORD & WATERBURY)

Take Route 84 West to Exit 16. At the end of the exit go left onto Route 188, South. Follow Route 188 to the first light. At the light go left onto Route 67, South. 2 1/2 miles past the Southford General Store turn right onto Hogsback Road. Go up the hill, when you pass Somers Lane on the left, look for house #59 on the left.
